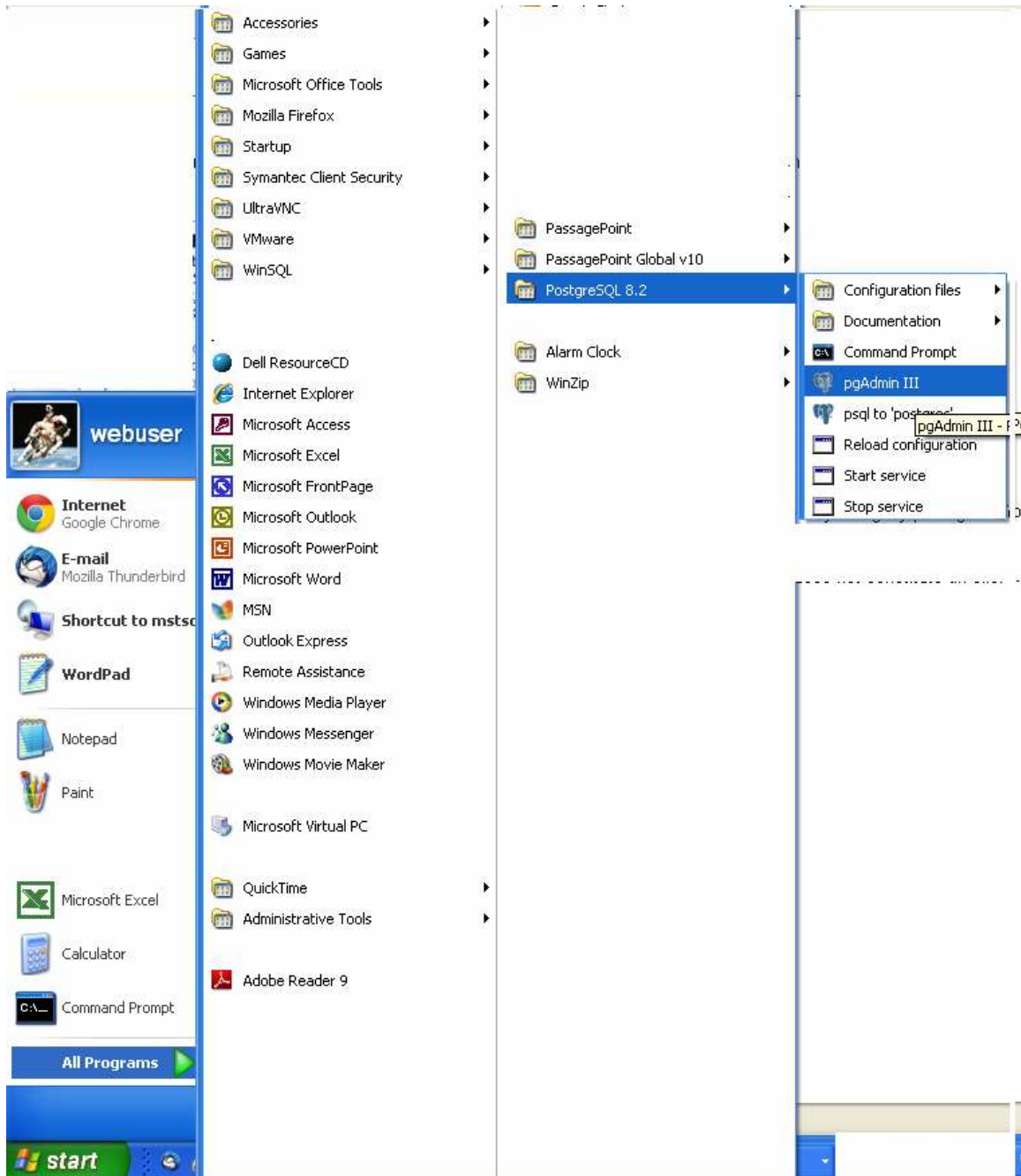


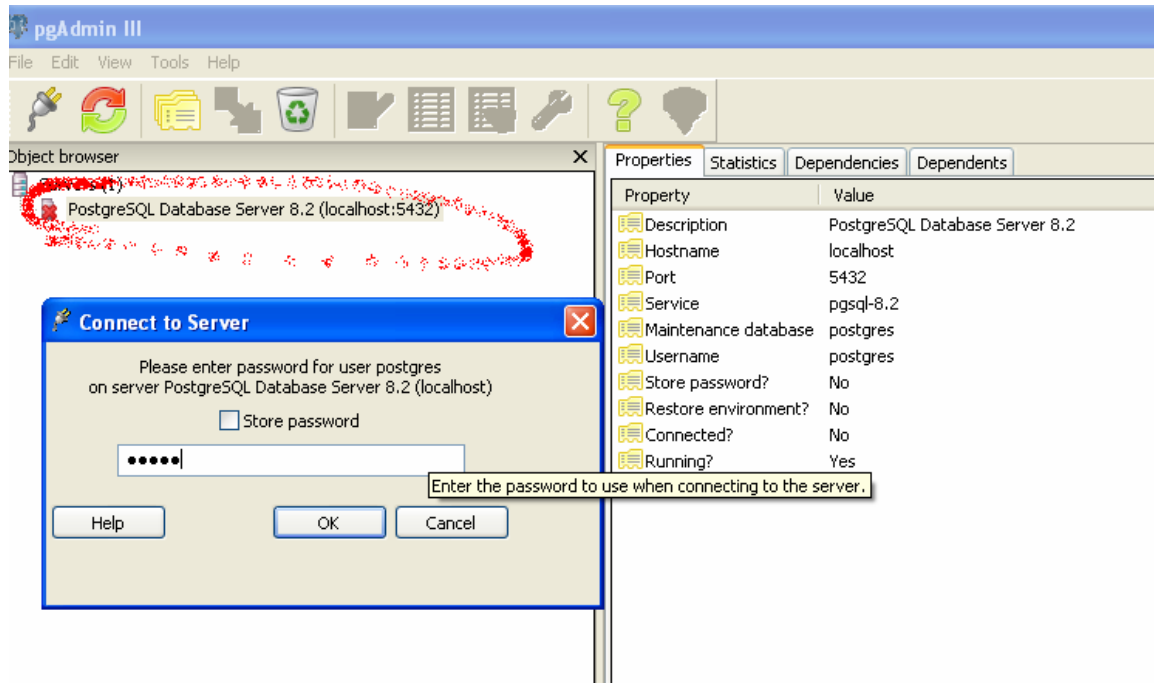
How to reset the Admin Password

Postgresql:

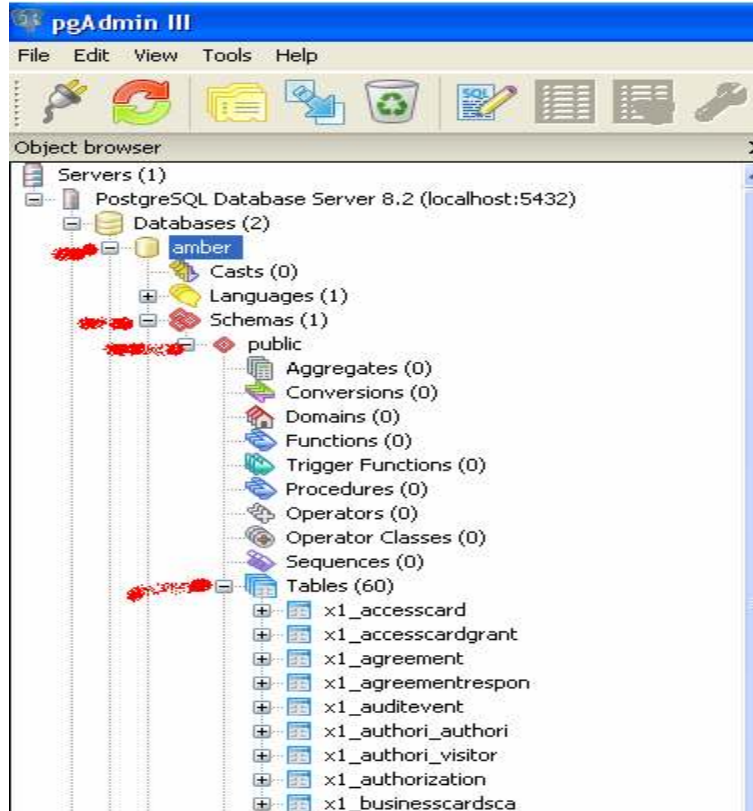
Select PPAdminIII and run



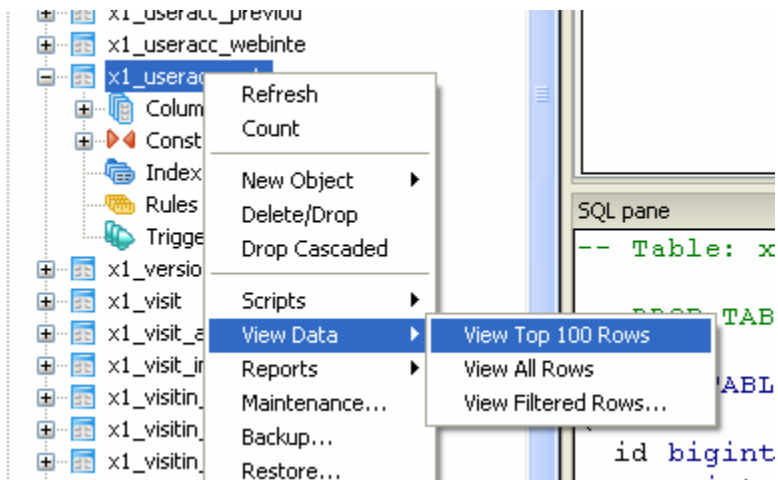
Click on “postgreSQL Database....” And enter “amber” for the password (without quotes).



Expand till you see tables



Find x1_useraccount and select “view top 100 rows”



Find the x_login account and click once in the x_password and change it to
